COMPOSITION OF BOARD / COMMITTEE: The Commission shall consist of up to nine (9) members, each who shall be residents of San Benito County or the Health & Human Services Agency Director or the County Health Officer. Membership shall consist of one (1) member of the Board of Supervisors, the Health and Human Services Agency Director, the County Health Officer and up to six (6) members who represent any of the following categories: 1) recipients of project services included in the county strategic plan; b) educators specializing in early childhood development; c) representatives of a local child care resource or referral agency or a local child care coordinating group; d) representatives of a local organization for prevention or early intervention for families at risk; e) representatives of community-based organizations that have the goal of promoting nurturing and early childhood development; f) representatives of local school districts; and g) representatives of local medical; pediatric or obstetric associations or societies. The by-laws were revised May 6, 2014.

Commission members shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Commission members shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors. The term of office of each member shall be for three (3) years until the appointment of his/her successor.
